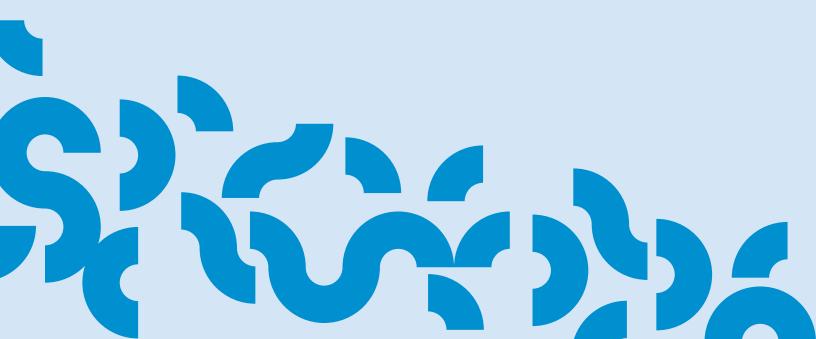

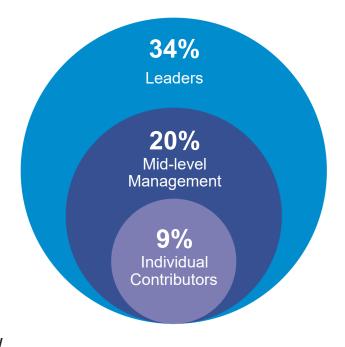

of your individual contributors feel highly confident in their ability to adapt to changes driven by artificial intelligence.

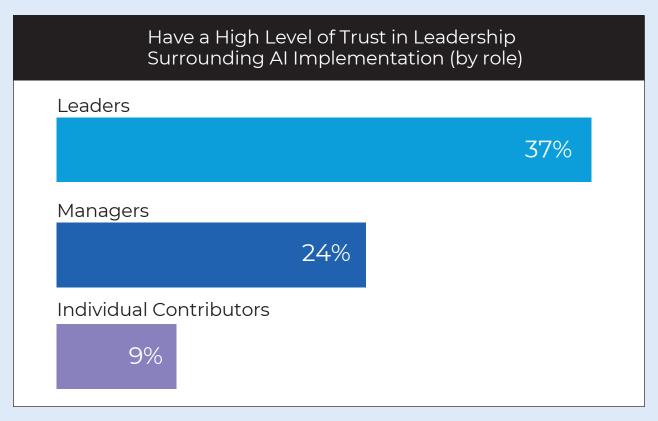




Differing Realities in the Workplace
